As a result of 2016 Senate Bill 1347a, Boundary County no longer keeps excess proceeds from the sale of tax-deeded properties. After excess proceeds are distributed to parties in interest who file valid claims, any remaining funds are sent to the Idaho State Treasurer, to be distributed as unclaimed funds.
