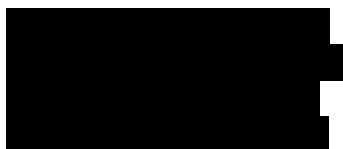

OFFICIAL MINUTES

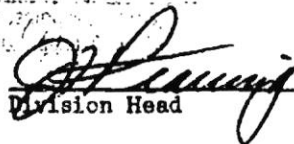
WHEREAS, construction of 4.433 miles of State Highway No. US 2, under Project No. FH 2-1(2), on new location beginning at a point 2.348 miles east of a junction with State Highway No. US 95 and ending at a point 1.274 miles east of the Moyie Springs Connection, has made continuance of the original road as a part of the State Highway System no longer essential, all as shown on the sketch map attached hereto, as Exhibit A, and

WHEREAS, removal of the superseded section of State Highway No. US 2 from the State Highway System is in accordance with a public hearing held October 24, 1960, at Moyie Springs, and

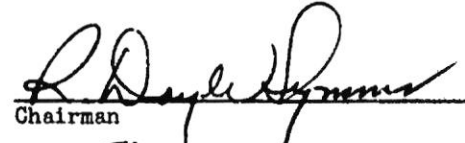
WHEREAS, Boundary County by official action dated June 29, 1964, did agree to assume responsibility for this section of State Highway No. US 2 upon completion of Project No. FH 2-1(2)

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that a section of former State Highway No. US 2, 5.800 miles in length and described as beginning at a point 2.348 miles east of a junction with State Highway No. US 95 and extending to a point 1.982 miles east of Moyie Springs, be and hereby is, removed from the State Highway System effective this date. Coincident with said removal, all jurisdiction, control, and interest of the State in and to said portion of former State Highway No. US 2 are relinquished to Boundary County and such highway shall constitute a public road.
