BOUNDARY COUNTY, STATE OF IDAHO**

**A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR
SUPPLEMENTAL LEVY ELECTION**

WHEREAS, the School District No. 101, Boundary County, State of Idaho (the "District") currently assesses a supplemental levy in the amount of \$2,400,000 per year for two (2) years, for the purpose of paying all lawful expenses of maintaining and operating the District for the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027.

WHEREAS, the District's current supplemental levy is set to expire on June 30, 2027.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 33-802(3), Idaho Code, as amended, the Board of Trustees of the District has determined there is a need for a supplemental levy in the amount of \$2,400,000 per year for two (2) years, for the purpose of paying all lawful expenses of maintaining and operating the District, as further described in the form of ballot question set forth in SECTION 3 herein, for the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2027, and ending June 30, 2029.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the District as follows:

SECTION 1. That a supplemental levy election be and the same is hereby called to be held in the District on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the District the question set out in the form of the ballot appearing in SECTION 3 hereof.

SECTION 2. That the Clerk of Boundary County, Idaho (the "County Clerk") shall administer and coordinate the election pursuant to and in accordance with Title 34, Idaho Code.

SECTION 3. That the form of the official ballot will be substantially as follows:

QUESTION: Shall the Board of Trustees of School District No. 101, Boundary County, State of Idaho, be authorized and empowered to levy a Supplemental Levy in the amount of Two Million Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,400,000) per year for two (2) years, commencing with the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2027 and ending June 30, 2029, for the purposes stated above; all as provided in the Resolution adopted by the Board of Trustees on August 17, 2026?

The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed levy is a tax of \$93 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions.

QUESTION: Shall the Board of Trustees of School District No. 101, Boundary County, State of Idaho, be authorized and empowered to levy a Supplemental Levy in the amount of Two Million Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,400,000) per year for two (2) years, commencing with the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2027 and ending June 30, 2029, for the purposes stated above; all as provided in the Resolution adopted by the Board of Trustees on August 17, 2026?

The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed levy is a tax of \$93 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions.

Said election will be conducted pursuant to Title 34, Idaho Code.

SECTION 5. That the Clerk of the Board of Trustees of the District (the "Clerk") is authorized to convey to the County Clerk the forms of the Official Ballot and the Notice of Supplemental Levy Election, appearing in SECTION 3 and SECTION 4 hereof, for election preparation and publication pursuant to Title 34, Idaho Code. The Clerk shall submit these forms to the County Clerk on or prior to August 28, 2026.

SECTION 6. That the County Commissioners of Boundary County, Idaho, shall act as the canvassing board pursuant to and in accordance with Title 34, Idaho Code, and will certify and convey the results to the Board of Trustees of the District as provided therein.

SECTION 7. That if at the election a simple majority of the qualified registered electors of the District authorize such levy, the supplemental levy shall be approved and become effective in accordance with the provisions of Section 33-802, Idaho Code.

A SPECIAL HOSPITAL TAX LEVY FOR MAINTAINING

WHEREAS, in accordance with Idaho Code § 31-3501, the Boundary County Board of Commissioners under advisement from the Boundary County Community Hospital Board has determined there is a need for a Special Hospital Tax Levy in the amount of \$1,500,000 per year for two (2) years, for the purpose of paying all lawful expenses of maintaining and operating the hospital, as further described in the form of ballot question set forth in SECTION 3 herein, for the fiscal years beginning January 1, 2027 and ending December 31, 2028.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Boundary County Commissioners for the Boundary County Community Hospital as follows:

SECTION 1. That a county Special Hospital Tax Levy for maintaining and operating the hospital is hereby called to be held in the County on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the County the question set out in the form of the ballot appearing in SECTION 3 hereof.

SECTION 2. That the Clerk of Boundary County, Idaho (the "County Clerk") shall administer and coordinate the election pursuant to and in accordance with Title 34, Idaho Code.

The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed levy is a tax of \$58 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions.

QUESTION: Shall the Boundary County Commissioners for Boundary County Community Hospital, Boundary County, State of Idaho, be authorized and empowered to levy a Special Hospital Tax Levy for maintaining and operating the hospital in the amount of One Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000) per year for two (2) years, commencing with the fiscal years beginning January 1, 2027 and ending December 31, 2028, for the purposes stated above; all as provided in the Resolution adopted by the by the Boundary County Commissioners on August 18, 2026. The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed levy is a tax of \$58 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions.

Said election will be conducted pursuant to Title 34, Idaho Code.

SECTION 5. That the Boundary County Commissioners for the Boundary County Community Hospital Board is authorized to convey to the County Clerk the forms of the Official Ballot and the Notice of Special Hospital Tax Levy for maintaining and operating the hospital, appearing in SECTION 3 and SECTION 4 hereof, for election preparation and publication pursuant to Title 34, Idaho Code. The forms shall be submitted to the County Clerk on or prior to August 28, 2026.

SECTION 6. That the County Commissioners of Boundary County, Idaho, shall act as the canvassing board pursuant to and in accordance with Title 34, Idaho Code, and will certify and convey the results to the Boundary County Community Hospital Board as provided therein.

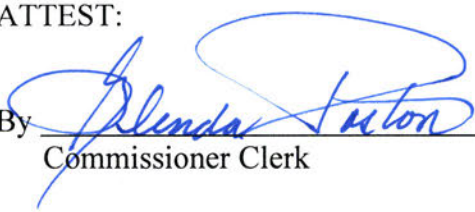
